With the swipe of a pen, Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing Steve Clark legislated changes that our neighbourhoods will have to live with for decades to come, and all without any consultation with the very people affected.

Here in Midtown, the MPP representing Eglinton-Lawrence, Robin Martin, has made herself noticeably scarce and never once met with the very constituents who will be affected by the changes to OPA405.
